Entry Procedure

1. Both ends must be PAID IN FULL to be considered for entry
 2. Cashiers check, money orders, company (sponsor) checks and credit cards accepted
 3. Personal checks ARE accepted
 4. ALL BFI "THE FEIST" ENTRIES BELONG TO THE SPONSOR(S) WHO PAID
 - It is at the discretion of the sponsor(s) to nominate you for your roping spot
- *****IF A SPONSOR DECIDES TO CHANGE ROPERS AND THE ROPING IS FULL, YOUR TEAM WILL BE PLACED ON THE WAITING LIST*******
5. Teams or individuals may be self-sponsored
 6. Two sponsors per roper can be printed in the program and read by the announcers
 7. All winnings, including cash and prizes, will be given directly to the ropers
 - It is up to the ropers and sponsors to work out personal and financial agreements
 8. 3% (\$150) will be held out for administration fees. \$4,850 per team goes to the purse
 9. Non-chosen teams and non-drawn waiting list teams will be 100% refunded
 10. First-time contestants must provide all recent roping accomplishments in order to be considered for entry
 11. All entries are subject to review
 12. The final draw will be posted at www.bfiweek.com on May 21st.

Regulations

1. This will be a six head competition featuring five full rounds
2. The top 15 teams in the average after the fifth round will advance to the short-go
3. Teams will be placed in roping order BUT late entered teams will rope first
4. The roping will start at team number 1 then drop down 20 teams to start the next round
5. 100 teams will be chosen by the BFI committee plus 10 additional waiting list teams
6. This is a professional event. Horse flesh and roper talent will be evaluated as such
7. PRCA dress-code will be strictly enforced
11. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry
